Notes:

- Two people who were unable to attend the Christmas Lunch generously donated their prepayments.
- As expected, 2022-2023 expenses increased over the prior year due to in-person meetings and inflation.
- At the end of June 2020 we had 61 paid members whereas this year we only have 48 a significant decline in membership.
- The membership dues have not kept up with increasing inflation and this year, despite the dues increase, we continue to anticipate higher expenses than revenue. The last dues increase was for 2016-2017 from \$40 to \$45.
- To protect the viability of the club the executive has been looking closely at expenses and ways to increase revenue but each of us can help by encouraging friends and family to join the club.
- The AGM count includes the speaker who was our guest so only 24 are included in the receipts.
 The Christmas Lunch welcomed Honorary President Joanna Gertler.
